### WORDS TO MAKE:

Give children clues about how many letters to use and how many letters to change. "Now we're going to make some three-letter words. Hold up three fingers! Change just the vowel and you can change the word *his* into *has*." For words like *has/ash* which can be made from the same letters, tell the children, "Don't take any letters out. Just change the letters around and you can change the word *has* into the word *ash*." For an unusual word like *arch*, give them a meaning they might understand. "The golden arch is the symbol for McDonalds."
